Purple Haze Anise Hyssop	Agastache 'Purple Haze'	perennial	3 ft.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	Vibrant, dark violet-purple flowers on strong, upright stems. Foliage is blue-green. Can be pinched to control height
Solar Prairieblues Indigo	Baptisia 'Solar Flare Prairieblues'	perennial	3-4 ft.	full sun	average, well-drained	Lemon yellow flowers blush orange as they age. Mature plants can have over 100 flowering stems! Shrub-like plant with blue-green foliage.
Starlite Prairieblues Indigo	Baptisia 'Starlite Prairieblues'	perennial	3 ft.	full sun	average, well-drained	Vivid violet buds open to periwinkle flowers with butter cream keels. One of the earliest varieties to bloom!
Twilite Prairieblues Indigo	Baptisia 'Twilite Prairieblues'	perennial	3-4 ft.	full to part sun	average, well-drained	Blooms are bi-colored deep violet and lemon yellow. Flowers May-June, blue-green foliage. Excellent architectural form in the garden and very unique color pattern!
Emerald Mist Brunnera	Brunnera macrophylla 'Emerald Mist'	perennial	12-15 in.	shade	average to moist	This plant is beautiful in the shade garden! Foliage is dusted with silver and has darker silvered collars around the perimeter of the leaf. Baby blue, forget-me-not type flowers
King's Ransom Brunnera	Brunnera macrophylla 'King's Ransom'	perennial	10-12 in.	shade	average to moist	Nice combination of silver and gold foliage with a frosted look over the entire heart-shaped leaf. Margins lighten to a creamy white by summer. Delicate blue flowers
Viking Bluebells	Campanula 'Viking'	perennial	15-18 in.	part sun	average to moist	New! Extremely floriferous, sterile hybrid. Eggplant purple buds open to lilac purple, bell-shaped blossoms that bloom at each node up the stem. Compact plant with deep green foliage

Summer Sorbet Bluebeard	<i>Caryopteris x clandonensis</i> 'Summer Sorbet'	perennial	3-4 ft.	full sun	average, well-drained	A green and yellow variegated selection that holds up in the sun. Periwinkle blue flowers and a compact, shrubby form
Dream Catcher Coreopsis	<i>Coreopsis</i> 'Dream Catcher'	perennial	14-18 in.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	A NEW threadleaf coreopsis with magenta pink flowers and a dark purple eye. Blooms all summer
Full Moon Coreopsis	<i>Coreopsis</i> 'Full Moon'	perennial	24-30 in.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	Well-branched stems with canary yellow flowers up to 3 inches across! Intermediate green foliage
Moonray Coreopsis	<i>Coreopsis verticillata</i> 'Moonray'	perennial	18-24 in.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	Vigorous and long-blooming with light creamy yellow flowers. Forms an airy clump of fine foliage
Route 66 Coreopsis	<i>Coreopsis verticillata</i> 'Route 66'	perennial	24-28 in.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	Large, 2 inch yellow flowers with a blood red eye, with the red pigment becoming dominant in fall. Well-branched, upright habit
Sunray Coreopsis	<i>Coreopsis grandiflora</i> 'Sunray'	perennial	18-24 in.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	Tickseed coreopsis that produces double and semi-double, deep golden flowers. Compact and floriferous and easy to grow! Excellent cut flower
Bright Eyes Crocosmia	<i>Crococsmia</i> Bright Eyes (3 / pot)	perennial	18-24 in.	sun to shade	average, well-drained	New! Brilliant orange flowers with prominent, scarlet red eyes. 8-12 flowers per stem ensures good floral impact in the garden!
Summer Blues Delphinium	<i>Delphinium grandiflora</i> 'Summer Blues'	perennial	10-12 in.	full to part sun	average, well-drained	Forms compact mounds of well-branched, lacy foliage. Sky blue flowers that bloom early. Heat tolerant

Firewitch Pinks	Dianthus 'Firewitch'	rock plant	6 in.	full sun	dry, well-drained	Raspberry-red flowers rebloom if deadheaded. Foliage forms a mat of silvery-blue. 2006 PPA Plant of the Year!
Fusion Pinks	Dianthus 'Fusion'	rock plant	10-13 in.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	New! Flowers emerge red and pink and eventually turn coral pink with a red eye. Spicy fragrance and blue-green foliage
Heart Attack Sweet William	Dianthus barbatus 'Heart Attack'	perennial	24 in.	full sun	average to dry, well-drained	Deep crimson red flowers in rounded clusters above glossy, dark green leaves. Foliage is a deep red when it emerges in spring

Burning Hearts Bleeding-Hearts	Dicentra 'Burning Hearts'	perennial	10-12 in.	shade	moist, organic	New! Striking rose-red, heart shaped flowers with a white edge. Foliage is a compact mound of blue-gray, finely textured leaves. Fantastic color combo!

Ghost Fern	Athyrium 'Ghost'	perennial	24-36 in.	full to part shade	moist, organic	Rigid, upright clumps with apple green fronds frosted silvery-gray. Tough, reliable fern for the shade garden

Fancy Wheeler Gaillardia	<i>Gaillardia aristata</i> 'Fancy Wheeler'	perennial	10 in.	sun	average, well-drained	Scarlet-red flowers rimmed in gold with a red center. Dwarf plant that blooms all summer

Red Jewel Helenium	<i>Helenium</i> 'Red Jewel'	perennial	30-36 in.	full sun	average, well-drained	Produces tight clusters of small, dusky-red flowers with a hint of blue. Some blooms will also have yellow tips. Great perennial for late season color
Sahin's Early Flowerer Helenium	<i>Helenium</i> 'Sahin's Early Flowerer'	perennial	30-36 in.	full sun	average, well-drained	Flowers are a deep red-orange streaked with yellow and tangerine-orange with a brown cone. Very long-blooming plant, a sure winner!
Summer Sun Heliopsis	<i>Heliopsis helianthoides</i> 'Summer Sun'	perennial	36 in.	full sun	average to dry	Bright golden flowers are semi-double and 3 inches wide! Strong stems and very heat tolerant
Alabama Sunshine Foamy Bells	<i>Heucherella</i> 'Alabama Sunrise'	perennial	12 in.	part sun to shade	average, well-drained	Large, deeply incised leaves with red veining that green up some during the summer. White flowers, very tolerant of heat and humidity. A bright addition to the shade garden

Mrs. Moon Pulmonaria	<i>Pulmonaria saccharata</i> 'Mrs. Moon'	perennial	10-12 in.	full to part shade	average to moist	Foliage is great for brightening up the shade garden. Magenta-pink buds open to bright blue flowers

Splendid Meadowrue	Thalictrum d. 'Splendide'	perennial	4-5 ft.	part sun	average to moist	Wonderful architectural plant for the moist border or woodland garden! Forms a lacy mass of green foliage with tall stalks of lavender mauve flowers. Use as a filler in cut bouquets
Black Snowflake Foamflower	Tiarella 'Black Snowflake'	perennial	8 in.	part sun to shade	average, well-drained	Lightly fragrant white flowers with glossy green and black-purple leaves that are deeply dissected. Forms a nice clump
Crow Feather Foamflower	Tiarella 'Crow Feather'	perennial	8 in.	part sun to shade	average, well-drained	Bright green leaves are lobed with black-purple centers. Winter color is a mix of pink, red, purple, and black. Flowers are tawny-pink and slightly fragrant
